Combining EHS Platforms

Currently, NAIP and NASP share environmental, health and safety (EHS) training, information, policies and reporting on separate online platforms. This creates challenges for collaboration between the two business units and can cause inconsistencies in policies, resources and messaging provided to facilities.

Part of the process of consolidating platforms includes the consolidation of EHS policies so all North American facilities operate under the same set of policies and procedures for implementing those policies. The consolidated platform will also enable uniformity in training and safety campaigns

across facilities in both business units as well as facilitate consistency in reporting metrics. In addition to the practical benefits, the consolidated platform is expected to result in a \$65,000 cost savings annually.
